




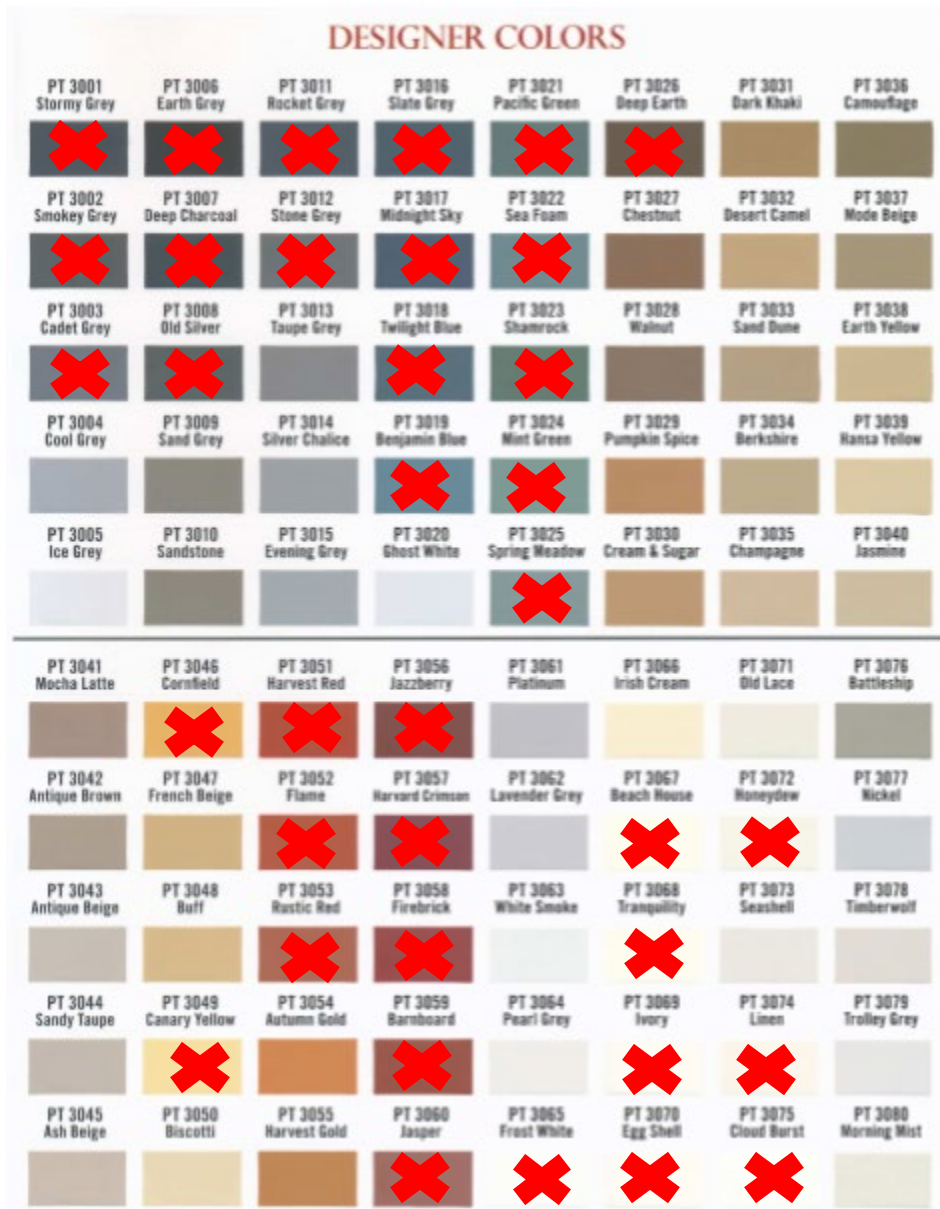

MINERAL STAINS COLOR CHART



All the "concrete or brick stains" that I saw from Home Depot, Lowes, Sherwin Williams Duron, Valspar, Behr, etc. are not true stains regardless of what the label says. They all have acrylic in them.

Most of the companies below seem to be able to do custom colors. They have pigments that they can dye to match any old or new brick, e.g. to match repairs, etc. Note the length of the warranties.
